Principal's Update

It was great to return to face-to-face learning once again this Wednesday. Staff and students were all relieved the lock-down finished and they could come back to regular classes.

Face Masks

Of course, there are still restrictions in place to keep us safe, one being the wearing of face masks. Can I ask parents to make sure your child understands they need to wear a mask at all times and has at least one spare mask carried with them. I have had to ask many students to put on their mask, particularly outdoors, and they seemed surprised that they needed one.

If students have an exemption, they need to carry their pass with them at all times in case they are approached by a staff member.

Staggered End of Day Dismissal times

It is important that you are aware of the times for early dismissal, listed in the Compass Notification I sent you. These times will stay in place until the Premier gives us further advice on restrictions. This will be for at least one and a half weeks:

To avoid the large mass of students exiting the school at once, we will stagger the end of day dismissal times to:

2:50pm dismissal for year 7 and 9 students3pm dismissal for year 8 and 10 students3:10pm dismissal (normal time) for 11 and 12 students
